CHILDREN'S MESSAGE

LESSON I

CEB

Jeremiah 31:31-34

³¹ The time is coming, declares the Lord, when I will make a new covenant with the people of Israel and Judah. ³² It won't be like the covenant I made with their ancestors when I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt. They broke that covenant with me even though I was their husband, declares the Lord. ³³ No, this is the covenant that I will make with the people of Israel after that time, declares the Lord. I will put my Instructions within them and engrave them on their hearts. I will be their God, and they will be my people. ³⁴ They will no longer need to teach each other to say, "Know the Lord!" because they will all know me, from the least of them to the greatest, declares the Lord; for I will forgive their wrongdoing and never again remember their sins.

May God add a blessing to this reading.

LESSON 2

On the evening of that day, the first day of the week, the disciples had gathered together in the upper room. Fearful of the Jews, they had locked all the doors in the house. Jesus came, and stood among them, and said, "Peace to you." Then he showed them his hands and side. The disciples rejoiced when they saw the Lord. Jesus said again, "Peace to you. Just as the Father sent me, I send you." When he had said this, he breathed on them and said, "Receive the Holy Spirit. If you forgive a person's sins, their sins have been forgiven them. If you retain the sins of any, they have been retained." But Thomas, sometimes called the Twin, one of the Twelve, was not with them when Jesus came. The other disciples were saying to him, "We have seen the Lord." But he said, "Unless I see the nail holes in his hands, put my finger in the mark of the nails and my hand in his side, I will not believe."

Eight days later, his disciples were again in the room and Thomas was with them. Although the doors were locked, Jesus came and stood in their midst and said, "Peace to you." Then he said to Thomas, "Take your finger and examine my hands. Take your hand and put it in my side. Do not doubt but believe." Thomas said, "My Lord and my God!" Jesus said, "Do you believe because you've seen with your own eyes? Blessed are those who have not seen and yet believe."

Jesus did many other miraculous signs in the presence of his disciples which are not written down in this book. These are written down so you may believe that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of God, and in believing, may have life through his name.
