LESSON I

CEB

James 5:13-20

¹³ If any of you are suffering, they should pray. If any of you are happy,
they should sing.

¹⁴ If any of you are sick, they should call for the elders of the church,
and the elders should pray over them, anointing them with oil in the
name of the Lord.

¹⁵ Prayer that comes from faith will heal the sick, for the Lord will
restore them to health. And if they have sinned, they will be forgiven.

¹⁶ For this reason, confess your sins to each other and pray for each
other so that you may be healed. The prayer of the righteous person is
powerful in what it can achieve.

¹⁷ Elijah was a person just like us. When he earnestly prayed that it wouldn't rain, no rain fell for three and a half years.

¹⁸ He prayed again, God sent rain, and the earth produced its fruit.

¹⁹ My brothers and sisters, if any of you wander from the truth and someone turns back the wanderer,

CEB

Mark 9:38-50

³⁸ John said to Jesus, "Teacher, we saw someone throwing demons out in your name, and we tried to stop him because he wasn't following us."

³⁹ Jesus replied, "Don't stop him. No one who does powerful acts in my name can quickly turn around and curse me.

⁴⁰ Whoever isn't against us is for us.

⁴¹ I assure you that whoever gives you a cup of water to drink because you belong to Christ will certainly be rewarded.

⁴² "As for whoever causes these little ones who believe in me to trip and fall into sin, it would be better for them to have a huge stone hung around their necks and to be thrown into the lake.

⁴³ If your hand causes you to fall into sin, chop it off. It's better for you to enter into life crippled than to go away with two hands into the fire of hell, which can't be put out.

⁴⁵ If your foot causes you to fall into sin, chop it off. It's better for you to enter life lame than to be thrown into hell with two feet.

⁴⁷ If your eye causes you to fall into sin, tear it out. It's better for you to enter God's kingdom with one eye than to be thrown into hell with two.

⁴⁸ That's a place *where worms don't die and the fire never goes out.*

⁴⁹ Everyone will be salted with fire.

⁵⁰ Salt is good; but if salt loses its saltiness, how will it become salty again? Maintain salt among yourselves and keep peace with each other."
